are for residents only. We are not equipped to accept large quantities from businesses.

You may bring:

Aluminum & Steel Cans,
Plastics #1-#7, including Plastic Bags,
Newspaper, Junk Mail, Gable Top Containers,
and Cardboard.

Styrofoam is NOT able to be recycled in this area. Please try to avoid the use of Styrofoam when possible, as it is considered trash.
