Timeline of activities

- Per employment: Capable of passing the State of Indiana D.O.T. physical exam Drug screen.
- Maintain; or Achieve and poses within 180 calendar days of transfer date a State Certified Commercial Driver's License (C.D.L.) Class "B" w/air breaks.
- Achieve and poses within 25 calendar months of employment, a Class I Wastewater Certification of employment.
- Certification required, Confined Space Entry.
- Considerable overtime is involved with this position, including working weekends and holidays.
- Facility operations on-call rotation within 180 days of employment.
- General knowledge and operation of Aqua-Tech & Vac-con within 180 days of employment.
- Cross train in Collections/Stormwater operations for a 30-day term each to better further your education of the treatment and flow process with-in 2 years.
- Direct supervisor, Facility Operations Foreman, and or Foreman's.
- A review of the employee's performance will be on or before 90 days of employment.
